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
Objectives

“For everyone to find his/her own path”

In addition to the other Cercle K2's activities, *Chemin K2* has created a friendly place of exchange, multidisciplinary and intergenerational, which motivates all its participants and offers a real support to those concerned with their professional career.

Chemin K2 enables exchanges between students and professionals, allowing them the freedom to express questions, experiences, aspirations and share their opinions of things happening in the professional world.

Chemin K2 gathers actors coming from different backgrounds and offers them the possibility to discover different professions, organizations and, more widely, universes often misunderstood or unknown by students.



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Content

2.1. Chemin K2's Commitments

Encounter : Students meet with professionals they do not always have the opportunity to meet.

Transmission and exchange : Based on their personal experience, the speakers transmit their knowledge and savoir-faire to the students in an open exchange.

Openness and tolerance : Access to information by students is made possible in an informal and positive environment.

Listening and availability : Professionals' quality to listen enables them to best meet students' needs.

Appropriate advice : Professionals' wise advice adapted to every student.

2.2. Organization of the exchanges

Objectives : to develop clear, open and benevolent discussions enabling mutual improvement; to help build adapted professional paths and anticipating professional evolutions.

Informal meetings or lunches : students discover or deepen their knowledge of the professional world and their understanding of its challenges by speaking with professionals during lunches or meetings.

Discussions on orientation : these meetings are also a chance for students to speak with professionals about academic and professional orientations and choices in a relaxing environment.

Advice on professional prerequisite :

- Skills assessment ;
- Writing a CV and a letter of motivation ;
- Employer's expectations for a training course ;
- What should be expected during a training course ;
- Valorization of the students' competences ;
- Assistance in the preparation for job interview.

2.3. Profiles

Students' profiles

Chemin K2 is dedicated to students from any educational background, between 18 and 25, studying in either a school or university.

Curious, volunteers, the students are open to exchange with actors from the professional world. They share the willingness to engage in thinking not only upon their career but more widely upon their future professional environment and its stake.

Tutors' profiles

Founding Members can decide to become a tutor for more than one student in order to support them in their career paths and selection.

Involved, listening and without prejudice, their mission is to exchange and answer student's questions but also encourage them to challenge their decisions, in order to help them find their professional paths (precise or not), to finalize the construction of their project, and to get familiar with any professional prerequisite.

Willing to participate in a mutual exchange, tutors share their experience, training and knowledge, in order to contribute to the construction of young professionals' career and to enrich them through this action.

Article 3 – Students' profile

Article 4 – Tutors' profile

Article 5 – Publicity

Article 6 – Organization of the exchanges

Participants can decide to become tutor for more than one student in order to support them on their career paths and choices.

Exchanges will be clear, open and benevolent.

Meetings or lunches will take place in public places according to the participants' availabilities.

The length of the exchanges is left to the participants' free judgment.



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
